

MICROCHIP CLINIC

A microchip clinic will be held at **Red Star Veterinary Clinic on Saturday, April 30** from **8:30-11am**, where a veterinarian or veterinary technician will be inserting microchips for **\$38**, which includes the microchip, insertion, and **LIFETIME REGISTRATION** enrollment in a recovery service. Why? Tags alone can get lost or be removed and microchipping is an easy way to permanently I.D. your pet.

No appointment necessary, Walk-Ins Only. For your pet's safety, please have your dog or cat on a leash or in carrier. Payment via Cash or Credit Card.

YOUR PET WILL BE CHIPPED – At the microchip clinic, a veterinarian or veterinary technician will microchip your pet. The tiny rice-sized I.D. is encoded with a unique number and implanted just under the skin in the scruff of the neck. The process is simple and only takes a few seconds.

YOUR PET WILL BE ENROLLED – At the microchip clinic, you will be provided with an enrollment form at the time the “chip” is implanted. Some other chips may be cheaper initially, but require an annual registration fee.

The “chip” can later be detected and read by a scanner used by shelters, dog wardens, humane societies, veterinarians, and other agencies if your pet is lost. **The owners are then notified in order to reunite them with their furry family members!**
