### **REQUIRED PROCEDURES & COSTS**

- Spay (girls) \$50 \*If a female is in heat at time of spay, an additional \$20 will be applied, and if is pregnant, \$50 applied.  
 Neuter (boys) \$40

Vaccinations listed below are **REQUIRED** in order to participate in the program. If you cat has had vaccinations, you must provide proof from a Veterinarian Office at the time of drop off. No exceptions.

### **OPTIONAL but HIGHLY RECOMMENDED PROCEDURES & COSTS** please make sure to check accept or decline on each item

- Feline Leukemia & FIV Blood Test (fatal terminal dz that increases risk of surgery) \$37 Accept  Decline   
Pre-anesthetic blood work prior to surgery: Check Liver, Kidneys, Sugar levels \$55 Accept  Decline   
Microchip Permanent Placement and Lifelong Registration \$42 Accept  Decline   
Flea Treatment/Prevention 30 day duration Single Dose Revolution applied today \$22 Accept  Decline   
Topical Prescription Strength Dewormer - Profender (tapes/rounds/hooks) applied today \$25 Accept  Decline

*To maintain a flea free environment at Red Star Vet, any pet admitted to with evidence of fleas will have a safe short term medication applied to kills the fleas at the cost of \$10 to the owner.*

## DROP OFF CHECKLIST

Arrive at Red Star Vet Clinic between 745-815AM – Due to the high volume of cats being dropped off on snap days, please plan for 10-15 minutes at drop off.

### What to bring to drop off...

#### Your Paperwork – 3 pages total

- SNAP ½ sheet carbon copy page – provided by the SNAP program
- SNAP Pre-Surgical Form COMPLETED –printed from Red Star Vet website
- SNAP Checklist (this page) – printed from Red Star Vet website

#### Your CAT Restrained in a Carrier – (1 cat per carrier)

- Carrier, Cage, box with air holes all accepted, no leashes. Please LABEL carrier/box with cat's name and your last name. This is for your cat's safety!)

## PICK UP CHECKLIST

Arrive at Red Star Vet Clinic between 5-530pm to pick up your cat companion – Due to the high volume of cats being discharged on snap days, please plan for 15-20 minutes at pick up.

### What to bring at pick up:

- A smile...Your feline friend is excited to see you!
- Your payment: Cash, credit card (visa, mc, disc), & care credit is accepted



### Post-Surgical Care Instructions for SNAP surgeries

-Due to the effects of anesthesia your pet may appear more tired than normal and possibly a little uncoordinated. This is to be expected, and the grogginess should subside in one to two days.

-If your pet becomes listless or anorexic over the next few days, or if vomiting or diarrhea occurs, call the veterinary clinic.

**Feeding Instructions:** To prevent vomiting, offer small amounts of water over the next several hours. If your pet doesn't vomit, then you may offer 1/4 of their normal meal tonight. Return to their normal feeding schedule and amount tomorrow.

**Incision Care:** Discourage licking or chewing of the surgical area. Call us if licking /chewing persists as a e-collar may be warranted if not already wearing one. If an e-collar has been placed on your pet, please keep in place for 7-10 days for female and 3-5 days for males. Check the incision site daily for any redness, swelling, or discharge. Report any of these immediately. If any sutures were placed they are absorbable unless told otherwise. Limit exercise for one week after surgery. (No running or jumping) No swimming or bathing for 2 weeks.

\*If a recheck is needed a few days after the surgery, the exam is included in the price of the surgery, but any additional medications will be a charged at that time. If you have any questions please call the clinic at (330) 871-8013.
